WHAT A PLAY! The Pontiac Game Changing Performance of the Year

IT WAS A SEASON full of plays worthy of "Pontiac Game Changing Performance" recognition. The four finalists included Appalachian State's upset victory over Michigan, Alabama's touchdown in the final seconds to defeat Arkansas and Auburn's gamewinning field goal over Florida.

But there can only be one "Pontiac Game Changing Performance of the Year" — the best of the best according to thousands of enthusiastic voters. In 2007 it was Trinity University's 15lateral play for a touchdown to beat

Millsaps College in Jackson, Miss., as time expired. The miraculous play took one minute to complete, netting Trinity national attention and a \$100,000 contribution to its general scholarship fund from Pontiac.

Since 2004, the Pontiac Game Changing Performance award has recognized tide-turning plays in men's NCAA football, as well as men's and women's NCAA basketball, that alter a game or even a team's whole season. Since the program's inception, Pontiac has contributed nearly \$1.5 million to the winning colleges' general scholarship funds.
